

Gorgeous Georgia

(10nights/11 Days)

Day 1-Arrival and Tbilisi City Orientation

Arrive at Tbilisi International Airport, where you will be greeted by your private driver and transferred to your hotel for check-in and some time to freshen up (subject to early room availability). After settling in, head out for lunch at a local restaurant offering traditional Georgian flavours.

Begin your first exploration of the capital with a leisurely walk along Rustaveli Avenue, the city's main boulevard lined with historic buildings, theatres, and shops. Continue to the picturesque Old Town and explore Chardin Street, filled with charming cafés, art galleries, and boutiques. Visit the famous Tbilisi Sulphur Baths area, stroll across the glass Bridge of Peace, and pause for photos around Freedom Square.

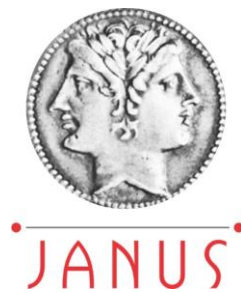
Later, admire the natural beauty of Leghvtakhevi Waterfall, explore the iconic Clock Tower, and then take the funicular up to Mtatsminda Park for lovely city views. After enjoying some free time at the park, return by car and transfer to a local restaurant for dinner. End the day with a drop-off back at your hotel for an overnight stay in Tbilisi.

Day 2: Mtskheta and Tbilisi Heritage Tour

After breakfast, set out on an excursion to Mtskheta, one of Georgia's oldest towns and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Visit the hilltop Jvari Monastery, offering stunning views of the Aragvi and Mtkvari rivers, followed by the Svetitskhoveli Cathedral, known as the spiritual heart of Georgia.

Upon returning to Tbilisi, visit the monumental Chronicles of Georgia, depicting key moments in Georgian history. Then, take the return cable car ride to Narikala Fortress for panoramic views over the Old Town and river valley. Stop by the Mother of Georgia statue before visiting landmarks such as the Bridge of Love, Metekhi Church, the grand Holy Trinity Cathedral, and Sioni Cathedral.

If time permits, take a relaxed stroll through nearby lanes lined with cafés and souvenir shops. In the evening, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant before returning to your hotel for an overnight stay in Tbilisi.



Day 3: Kakheti Wine Region and Countryside

After breakfast, drive east towards the Kakheti region, Georgia's premier wine-making area. Stop in Bidauri village for a delightful experience of tasting freshly baked Georgian bread and local cheese made in the traditional style.

Continue your journey to the picturesque town of Signaghi, known as the "City of Love," with its cobblestone streets and panoramic views of the Alazani Valley. Visit the beautiful Bodbe Monastery, which holds great religious significance, before taking a peaceful walk around Ilia Lake.

Later, visit a traditional Kakhetian wine cellar to sample locally made wines and learn about Georgia's ancient qvevri winemaking traditions. Return to Tbilisi in the evening for dinner at a local restaurant and an overnight stay at your hotel.

Day 4: Ananuri–Gudauri–Kazbegi Scenic Route

After breakfast and check-out, drive along the fascinating Georgian Military Highway towards the mountains. Stop first at the turquoise-blue Zhinvali Reservoir for photos before continuing to explore the historic Ananuri Fortress Complex situated on its banks. Journey onward to Gudauri, Georgia's popular mountain resort, where you'll pause at the Gudauri Panorama for breathtaking views of the Caucasus.

(Optional: Enjoy a cable car ride from Gudauri to Kobi to take in the stunning landscapes stretching across the valleys below.).

Spend some time at leisure exploring the local area before proceeding to Kazbegi. Upon arrival, check in at your hotel, relax, and get ready for dinner at a local restaurant.

Return to your hotel for overnight accommodation in Kazbegi.

Day 5: Kazbegi Highlights and Mountain Adventures

Start the day with breakfast at the hotel, followed by an adventurous 4x4 drive up the mountains to visit the iconic Gergeti Trinity Church, spectacularly perched beneath Mount Kazbek. Take in the serene view of the surrounding peaks and valleys, then, if open, continue along the scenic route to the Dariali Valley and Gorge, located near the Russian border.

Return to Kazbegi for free time at the local market where you can browse souvenirs, local crafts, and handmade products. In the evening, head to a restaurant for dinner before returning to your hotel for an overnight stay in Kazbegi.



Day 6: Journey to Kutaisi and City Exploration

After an early breakfast, begin your scenic drive to Kutaisi, one of Georgia's most historic cities. Upon arrival, start your tour with a visit to Bagrati Cathedral, beautifully perched on a hill and offering views across the city. Continue to Gelati Monastery, a UNESCO-listed complex of great cultural value, followed by the charming Motsameta Monastery set above the Rioni River. Take a pleasant walk through the city center to see the Colchis Fountain, the White Bridge, and the picturesque riverside views.

After sightseeing, check into your hotel, freshen up, and enjoy dinner at a local restaurant before an overnight stay in Kutaisi.

Day 7: Prometheus Cave and Martvili Canyon

After breakfast, set off to explore Prometheus Cave, one of the most impressive cave systems in Georgia, featuring colorful lighting and captivating rock formations. Enjoy a short boat ride through the underground sections if conditions allow. Continue to Martvili Canyon, where you can take a boat ride through the narrow emerald-green gorge, surrounded by waterfalls and steep cliffs.

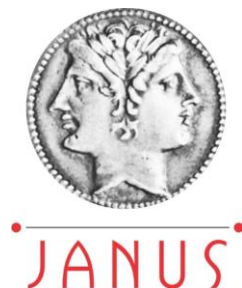
If time permits, visit Kutaisi's local market for handicrafts and fresh local produce before returning to your hotel. Dinner will be arranged at a local restaurant before overnighting again in Kutaisi.

Day 8: Batumi

Transfer to Batumi, the beautiful seaside city on the Black Sea. Begin your tour by visiting the lush Batumi Botanical Garden, followed by a walk around Batumi Piazza with its distinct European charm. Admire the iconic Ali and Nino statue, see the musical fountain show at Ardagani Lake, and enjoy the Batumi Boulevard's relaxing seafront promenade. Enjoy a scenic view of Batumi by enjoying a cable car ride there. After checking into your hotel and freshening up, transfer to a restaurant for dinner. Optional evening activities include a ride on the Ferris Wheel, visiting the observation deck at the Alphabetic Tower for night views of the city. Overnight stay in Batumi.

Day 9: Adjarian Mountains and Waterfalls

After breakfast, take a scenic excursion to the Adjarian Mountains to visit the impressive Makhuntseti Waterfall and the historic stone bridge nearby. Enjoy some quiet time surrounded by nature, then return to Batumi to visit any attractions missed the previous day or enjoy some shopping and seaside relaxation. In the evening, dine at a coastal restaurant before returning to your hotel for the night.



Day 10: Return Journey to Tbilisi via Borjomi and Uplistsikhe

Start early for your drive back to Tbilisi, with en route visits to Borjomi Central Park, Uplistsikhe Cave Town, and the Stalin Museum in Gori. Enjoy your final dinner in Tbilisi at a traditional restaurant, followed by a leisurely evening at your hotel. Overnight stay in Tbilisi.

Day 11: Departure from Tbilisi

After breakfast, check out and meet your driver for your private transfer to Tbilisi Airport for your onward flight, marking the end of a memorable Georgian journey.
